Permaculture Zones:

- 1 patio and surrounding raised beds, mini-greenhouse and containers. High care
- 2 "Vegetable garden". moderate care, moderate water (irrigate 1-2x/week). includes polyculture intensive bed, self-perpetuating bed, wall vines
- 3 "Xeriscape and Forest Garden" area. low care, low water (irrigate 1-2x/month), civilized appearance
- 4 (under development)
- 5 "California Natives" area. low care, low water (irrigate 1x/month)
